Accommodation

Fontys arranges accommodation on request in Venlo nearby the campus. The costs for accommodation (maximum 2 nights) will be paid by Fontys!

How to travel to Venlo?

You can go by car, train or plane to Venlo. Near Venlo there are **five airports** available: Düsseldorf-Weeze (35 km), Düsseldorf International (60 km), Eindhoven (60 km), Cologne-Bonn (100km) and Dortmund (150km). **If you arrive in one of those airports you have to take train, bus or taxi to come to the Venlo station,** where one of our students will wait for you.
